ANNIE E. SWIFT, being first duly sworn,
deposes and says as follows:

I, ANNIE E. SWIFT, of Napa, California, hereby make the statement that I am the Annie Laurie Harrison referred to in an affidavit executed by Nancy J. Thomas, of Santa Rosa, California, on the 7th day of _____, 1923, and that Marvin W. Harrison, of Lower Lake, California, is my brother.

I was born January 2nd, 1862, and my mother who died July 6th, 1921, was Isabela Springer (born August 6th, 1842). She married Ephraim Harrison at Sacramento, in 1861.

My mother's father was George W. Springer, born April 8th, 1802, died September 29th, 1854; and my brother and I are in possession of his old Bible in which he wrote the date of his birth as above given, and the birth of his wife to be 1812. He wrote his wife's name "Loisanna Springer", and gave dates of births of all the children. I know he married Loisanna Green who was an aunt to Nancy J. Thomas of Santa Rosa, California; and my brother and I have the diary he wrote on his trip across the plains in 1852. The diary is in exactly the same handwriting as that in the Bible and tells that he started from Niles, Michigan, April 6th, 1852 and got to Sacramento December 1, 1852.

I have before me a copy of a letter from Barney Springer Martin, of Oregon, to my brother showing descendants of Noah Springer - son of Isaac Springer. This letter shows Noah had a son George W., born in 1802.

I have also read a letter written to my brother April 1st, 1914 by E. L. Scribner of Amesbury, Mass. giving dates as follows:

NANCY J. THOMAS, being first duly sworn deposes and says: that she is a resident of Santa Rosa, State of California; that she is a first cousin to Mrs. Isabela Harrison who died at Napa, California, July 6th. 1921, and that she was a daughter of George W. Springer who left Niles, Michigan April 6th. 1852 and crossed the plains to California, landing in California the same year. Isabela was also called Bell and Isabela.

That George W. Springer's wife was my father's sister; that her maiden name was Louisanna Green and my father was William Green; that Mr. Springer and family, my father and family and Joseph Suits, who married Louisa (or Idza) M. Springer all started for California together; that we split up and Springer and family came the southern route, landing in Sacramento from Monterey in the Fall of 1852, coming from Monterey by boat; he died in 1854 at Sacramento, his wife a few years later moved to Lower Lake, Lake County, California, where she was buried in 1872;

George W. Springer and Loisanna had thirteen children the dates of birth of himself, his wife and the children were written in a bible now in possession of Mrs. W. T. Swift of Napa, California and were undoubtedly written there by him because the handwriting compares with the writing in a diary kept by him on his way across the plains; the old diary being in the hands of Mrs. W. T. Swift and her brother, Marvin W. Harrison of Lower Lake, Lake County, California;

Isabela (or Bell) married Ephraim Harrison in Sacramento, 1861 and had two children, Marvin W. and Annie Laurie. Annie now being Mrs. W. T. Swift; she knows that of the

thirteen children of George W. Springer only two are still living, they being George D. W. Springer and Nelson Leroy Springer of Baker City, Oregon, another son, (Van ren salaer Springer, died at Uvalda, Texas, a few years ago leaving some children there.

Loiza M. Springer married Joseph Suits and died leaving two girls, Mary and Loisanna. Loisanna, in 1870, married T. H. Smith and lives at Lower Lake, California and she was told that Mary married Alfred McAllister at Sacramento, October 22nd. 1867.

Sarah Springer married Stephen HYTE and died, leaving some children. Rosanna P. Springer married Caleb F. Ives and died, leaving one girl (Dora Jane Ives).

Marvin W. Harrison was born 19th day of November, 1864, and Mrs. W. T. Swift was born January 2nd. 1862.
